



Grade Suppression Request

Repeated Course for Credit Grade Suppression is a process that replaces a previously stored failing grade or non-failing grade with a new stored grade. This policy (State Board of Education Policy GCS-M-001) only applies to courses taken in 2015-2016 and after.

Suppression of a grade means the suppressed grade is:

- Excluded from the GPA, transcript, Class Rank and Honor Roll.

Students have the 1st Ten days of the semester to request a suppression for a course being repeated. Only one course per academic year may be taken for suppression.
