# School Profile: 2022-23

OVERVIEW

Offering a rigorous college-preparatory curriculum with a strong emphasis in math and science, Triangle Math and Science Academy will graduate students prepared for enrollment in competitive universities, utilizing a variety of instructional opportunities such as AP courses, Pre-AP courses, PLTW courses, CTE courses, dual enrollment courses through local community colleges and universities, and internships. In order to assist students in becoming well-rounded citizens, they are encouraged to complete 100 community service hours before graduation. Our first class graduated in May of 2019. High school students enroll in 8 courses per year on a year round A/B day schedule.

## ATHLETICS, ACADEMIC TEAMS & STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

At TMSA, it is our mission to use athletics to aid in academic, social, and physical development of our students through promotion of teamwork and sportsmanship through interscholastic athletics. Our high school is a member of the NCHSAA as a part of the Central Tar Heel 1A Conference. Our school offers the following sports: Baseball, Basketball (Men's and Women's), Cross Country (Men's and Women's), Soccer (Men's and Women's), Men's Tennis, and Volleyball. At the middle school level, we offer: Baseball, Basketball (Boys and Girls), Cross Country (Boys and Girls), Soccer (Boys and Girls) and Volleyball.

High school students are offered the opportunity to join student organizations such as Student Council, National Honors Society, HOSA, Red Cross Club and many more.

Students are provided multiple opportunities to compete in national competitions in a number of subject areas. Academic teams include: Science Olympiad, DECA, and FTC Robotics. The number of academic teams will grow as our school grows.

### Class of 2022

67% of the Class of 2022 plan to attend a four-year university and 33% plan to attend a 2-year college. They were accepted at 65 different colleges and universities and chose to attend 14 different institutions. Our top three matriculations were UNC Chapel Hill, North Carolina State University and UNC Charlotte. The average SAT score was 1276 and the average ACT was 27.
